

Millcreek Township Monthly Meeting for June 10th, 2026

Vice-Chairman, Fred Brandstetter called the Wednesday, June 10, 2026, meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the pledge of allegiance. Three supervisors were present along with three township residents. May meeting minutes read and approved with Fred making the motion, John seconding motion Andy making motion unanimous. May's treasures' report presented and accepted by the supervisors. treasurers' report the Farmers CD balance \$943.20. Escrow Account is \$5427.00 ATV application deposits \$210.00 with ending balance of \$5637.00 General Fund beginning balance was \$133,975.16 total debits \$25,107.89 total credits \$50,344.67 interest for the month \$2.33 for the year \$12.36 ending balance \$159,211.94. Liquid Fuels account beginning balance is \$162,763.92 total debits \$9,765.87 interest for the month \$2.53 for the year \$10.81 ending balance \$153,000.58. Top Tier Federal Credit Union 3.85% 6month CD beginning balance \$120,909.34 interest for the month \$388.17 ending balance \$121,297.51 2026 Clean Up Day \$161.75 was the recycling Church Donation \$475.00 two donations totaling \$65.00 total of \$701.75 invoice from Yard works \$875.70 sur charge for fuel was \$ 169.00. They did pick the dumpster up at 3:00 pm. on Saturday. The treasurers report was accepted as presented.

Bill paying: Auto-payment Windstream, United Electric, cardmember (credit card) Walmart, USDA, Payroll Liabilities, Pa Dept of Revenue, Star Link. Intuit, Vicki Johnson Tax Collector, Hovis Auto & Truck Supply, Eastern Alliance, Swift Yard Works, Collin Fantaskey. Intuit is back to charging for \$3.00 per person per payroll. In February 2024 they encouraged Townships to upgrade to QuickBook Enterprise and they would not charge per person for payroll. They are back to charging for this service.

Public Comments: 5 minutes per person: Potholes on Old State South, Aaron Drive by the bridge are very bad when will work begin on this area? Speed limits? Comments made again about how fast Fed-Ex and UPS drive down the road. What can be done with the dust on the dirt roads? Questions was asked if we know anything about dirt roads having a 35 mph speed limit? Discussion took place on how the Spring down on Gravel Lick looks better. Ridge Road ditches need cleaned.

Equipment will be moved to Old State South and Aaron Drive after the work is completed on Work Drive. Discussion took place about cleaning ditches and the material left on the side of road. Discussion took place on building a structure to keep material dry. Andy reported the wood trusses are no longer available. Fred stated Rod Frampton would move our convex box that we do have to new location on the grounds. Discussion then took place about needed equipment and equipment that we need to sell. Fred said he would take pictures of the truck and post on Market Place. Items that were mentioned that the township could use were a Hydro Dig, new Roller, stone rake wider bucket on backhoe. Our roller has had the hydraulic line work on. The F-550 has an appointment next Friday. John then discussed the truck that is for sale at La Pierre's Garage in Sigel. The vehicle was discussed, and the supervisors agreed they would go look at it. The supervisors then discussed when they would be on vacation.

Secretary/Treasurer Update: Banking, reconcile QuickBooks, payroll, bill paying, mail, filing, spoke with Kinetic about phone price, worked with Veronica with Liquid Fuels Audit, Application for Executive Officer Exception for Fire Company paperwork.
